



TELEMEDECINE CHARTER

The deployment of telemedicine aims to enable patients to obtain health care adapted to their needs (particularly in isolated sanitary areas) through the participation of a general practitioner or specialist «at a distance", so to speak by tele-consultation. At all times the confidentiality and security of the data exchanged are guaranteed.

As such, telemedicine is a truly useful tool for the organization and access to health care.

The medical association **ESA** (Espoir Santé Afrique) commits to make available all the data relating to its activity and the medical service rendered to the tele-expert, in particular in the management of chronic diseases.

The strategic objective/goal is to optimize the reception, orientation and health care of people in isolated areas, by facilitating the medical information through secured sharing.

The tele-consultation interview comes as a "complementary service" in addition to the face-to-face interaction between the practitioner and the beneficiary, it is not a "replacement".

By signing the following charter, the doctor commits, with regard to his/her practice, to respect the code of medical ethics.

The remote expert, at this stage of the project, participates exclusively on a «volunteer» basis.

Eventually, online payment for expertise could be considered in the future, depending on the progress and development of the project.

By respecting the charter, the managers of the hosting platform commit as well to guarantee and implement all the procedures that are necessary to ensure that the tele-expert respects the commitments he/she has made.



This agreement is established for one year. It will be renewed by tacit agreement unless opposed by one of the parties.
